ADDICTIONS AND RECOVERY

The Addiction Treatment and Recovery Services continues to build on services offered to community members of Rainy River First Nations. Our core services include Intervention, Intake, Assessment, Counseling, Group Work (when feasible), out-patient treatment and aftercare services. Our clients are provided individualized treatment plans and holistic support services which enhance their ability to remain free from the consumption of alcohol and/or illicit drugs. Along with these core individual services the program offers support to family members who struggle to understand addiction and effects on family life. We also provide medically assisted services using Suboxone for clients who are addicted to opiates and seeking abstinence from this addiction. Below is a flow of service.

FLOW OF SERVICES- ADDICTION/TREATMENT SERVICES

Intake - Application for service, confidentiality agreement, client agreement, recovery contract.
Quick screen Assessment- (Jellinek Progressive curve of Addiction), D.A.S.T. assessment.

Recovery Services Programs - intervention, family counselling (future), detoxification(future), individual counselling, out-patient and in-patient treatment service (future), Suboxone orientation and doctor appointment, community support and counselling/programming while awaiting treatment options, community awareness/prevention plan/programming, aftercare services. Individualized recovery plan and program for each client entering services.
