**Essential Skills** - excavation and construction principles & techniques with practical application of weights, volumes, conversion, and the costs associated with construction. Practical exercises with site layout, staking, survey and applied mathematical calculations.

#### **Work Placement**

Pre-apprentices earn a wage rate of **\$16.00/hour** during the **8-week** work placement with a Local 793 contractor.

Participating contractors are eligible to a wage subsidy of up to \$2,000 at the end of the 8-week work placement.
