Reporting to the Transition Home Manager, the Pre-Post Treatment Attendant is responsible for providing community-based Addictions and Recovery Services to the Treatment Centre of Rainy River First Nations.

### Primary Accountabilities Include:

- Assisting in administration of medication.
- Supervising residents in daily activities.
- Facilitating recreation and wellness programs in a community context.
- Providing Crisis Intervention and supportive counselling/containment.
- Completing required documentation throughout shift as well as program notes and incident reports.
- Liaising with full-time staff.

### Position Requirements:

- Post Secondary Diploma or working towards a University Degree relating to Social Services.
- Previous experience in the field of addictions and residential treatment. A combination of education and relevant experience may be considered.
- Demonstrated computer skills including experience using Microsoft Office programs.
- Excellent communication, organizational, time management and interpersonal skills.
- Must be able to work independently with minimal supervision in a fast-paced environment.
- Strong group facilitation, containment and crisis intervention skills.
- Exceptional organizational, liaison and advocacy skills.
- Must be willing and able to perform light housekeeping chores, including but not limited to laundry, cleaning staff offices, cooking meals etc.
- Stay-awake position requiring Treatment Attendant to stay awake throughout overnight shift.
- Must have Emergency First Aid/CPR Level 1 certification or willingness to obtain.
- Knowledge of Rainy River First Nation or Treaty #3 and Anishinaabe culture.
- Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector screening.
- Valid driver's license and satisfactory driver's abstract.
- Adherence to Rainy River First Nations' Drug Testing Policy.
