EARLY INTERVENTION & AFTERCARE WORKER- MARCH 2024

Under the supervision of the Director of Treatment & Recovery Services, the Early Intervention & Aftercare Worker provides mental health and addictions counselling to clients, including substance abuse assessments, pre-treatment activities, and aftercare and relapse prevention activities.

Primary Accountabilities Include:

- Facilitating pre-treatment services and counselling to clients requiring residential treatment or with concurrent disorders.
- Providing aftercare, awareness and relapse prevention education and information to individuals, their families and the overall community.
- Coordinating intake and assessment services.
- Promoting healthy lifestyles within the First Nation community by sharing information, liaising activities, promoting programming and other services of early intervention, aftercare and relapse prevention.
- Facilitating or attending group sessions, including youth/elder, recovery and family groups.
- Preparing accurate case and progress notes and reports and attending case reviews.

Position Requirements:

- Minimum two-year Addictions or Social Work Diploma or related field. A three-year BSW Degree is preferred. Combination of related education and experience will be considered.
- A minimum two years' experience in the field of addictions or a combination of training and experience in working with First Nations.
- Sound knowledge of the First Nations culture and the principal issues affecting the well-being of RRFNS individuals, families and community.
- Sound knowledge of the positive First Nation traditional influences that could promote mental health and wellness of RRFNS individuals and families in the community.
- Demonstrated ability to develop and maintain respectful, cooperative working relationships with individuals, families, community and service workers.
- Ability to understand or speak Ojibwe language would be considered an asset.
- Excellent interpersonal, written and oral communication skills.
- Demonstrated group facilitation skills.
- Criminal record check and vulnerable sector screening.
- Valid driver's license and satisfactory driver's abstract.
- Adherence to Rainy River First Nations' drug testing policy.
