Kay-Nah-Chi-Wah-Nung, the Place of the Long Rapids, is a place of outstanding beauty and spirituality.

The Centre is owned and operated by Rainy River First Nations and offers interpretive tours and galleries, a collections space with over 16,000 artifacts, a gift shop that showcases artwork by local Indigenous artists, and a restaurant with a menu featuring traditional Anishinaabe ingredients.

We have the following seasonal employment opportunities currently available:

Tour Guide:

Duties: Meet and lead visitors while acting as a subject matter expert in sharing stories and facts about the land's history. Majority of daily work is performed in outside conditions.

Requirements: Friendly and enthusiastic attitude, passion for the history and culture of Kay-Nah-Chi-Wah-Nung and excellent communication and interpersonal skills.

Cook:

Duties: Responsible for planning, preparing and cooking food items. Ensuring the highest quality service and experience to visitors and patrons at the historical centre.

Requirements: Previous cooking experience, graduation from a culinary program is considered an asset, food handlers' certificate, good communication skills and the ability to stand for long periods of time performing repetitive tasks.

Waitress:

Duties: Provide excellent customer service and delivery of food and beverage to visitors and patrons at the historical centre.

Requirements: Previous waitress and customer service experience considered an asset. Knowledge of cash handling.

Receptionist:

Duties: Greet visitors as they enter the premises, answer phones and respond to emails and basic administrative tasks including handling incoming and outgoing mail.

Requirements: Previous experience in a receptionist role is an asset, excellent customer service and verbal communication skills.

Other Requirements:

- Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector screening.
- Adherence to Rainy River First Nations' Drug Testing Policy.
