The Education Assistant is responsible for supporting and assisting the teacher with the delivery of programs to special needs students of Rainy River First Nations. They assist in keeping students they are supporting engaged in the assigned activities that take place in the learning environment which may include both group work and one on one support in collaboration with the teacher, they contribute to a culture of school safety and reinforce a positive and welcoming environment for all.

Primary Accountabilities include:

- Responding to the needs of the students, the teacher or the school team in a timely and appropriate manner.
- Explaining, demonstrating and modelling the skills and attitudes needed to encourage and support a healthy learning environment.
- Becoming familiar with students' specific learning needs and preferences, and applicable individual education or behavior intervention plans as required.
- Resolving situations that may pose safety risks to students or compromise educational opportunities.
- Building positive relationships with teachers and faculty alike.

Position Requirements:

- Minimum Grade 12 diploma or equivalent.
- College/diploma in the human services field including Early Childhood Education (ECE, Youth Care Worker (YCW), Educational Assistant (EA) is preferred.
- Previous experience as an Education Assistant is preferred.
- Excellent problem-solving skills, negotiation and mediation skills.
- Strong interpersonal and verbal communication skills.
- Excellent planning and organizational skills.
- Demonstrated patience and compassion towards children in challenging or difficult situations.
- Ability and willingness to perform required physical tasks.
- Criminal record check and vulnerable sector screening.
- Valid driver's license and satisfactory driver's abstract.
- Adherence to Rainy River First Nations' drug testing policy.
