Reporting to the Community Health Director, the Home and Community Care Support Worker is responsible for maintaining a clean, safe, and comfortable living environment. This role supports the overall well-being of the household by providing domestic care, managing daily routines, and ensuring that the home runs smoothly and effectively.

Primary Accountabilities

- Perform general housekeeping tasks such as cleaning, dusting, vacuuming, laundry, and dishwashing.
- Prepare, cook, and serve nutritious meals and snacks.
- Maintain household organization, including tidying common areas, bedrooms, and storage spaces.
- Provide light seasonal or deep cleaning (e.g., windows, cupboards, carpets).
- Ensure the home environment is safe by recognizing hazards and maintaining cleanliness standards.
- Maintain discretion and respect for the privacy and dignity of household members.
- May be utilized as coverage for the Medical Van Driver.
- In-office clerical duties and other related tasks as assigned.

Qualifications

- Knowledge and respect for the community's culture, traditions, practices and lifestyles.
- Knowledge of elder care and senior citizen health issues.
- Must have excellent communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Strong organizational and time management skills.
- Ability to follow instructions and complete tasks independently.

- Reliability, dependability, and attention to detail.
- Clerical experience considered an asset.
