

# Rainy River First Nations – Job Posting

## CASUAL ANIMAL CONTROL WORKER– August 2026



### Casual Position

Under the direction of Public Works Manager, the Animal Control Worker will handle animals when there is investigation of mistreatment, and to gain control of abandoned, dangerous, or unattended animals.

### PRIMARY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Capture and remove stray, uncontrolled, trapped, or abused animals from undesirable conditions.
- Remove captured animals from animal-control service vehicles and place animals in shelter cages or other enclosures.
- Clean facilities and equipment such as dog pens and animal control trucks.
- Examine animals for injuries or malnutrition. Arrange for any necessary medical treatment.
- Provide humane care to animals under your supervision.
- Euthanize rabid, unclaimed, or severely injured animals.
- Contact animal owners to inform them that their pets are at animal holding facilities.
- Organize the adoption of unclaimed animals.
- Educate the public about animal welfare, and animal control laws and regulations.
- Issue warnings in connection with animal-related offences and examine animal licenses to ensure compliance with laws.
- Investigate reports of animal attacks or animal cruelty. You may be required to interview witnesses, collect evidence, and write reports.
- Prepare for prosecutions related to animal treatment and give evidence in court when required.

### POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to interact with the public and skillfully navigate difficult situations.
- Physical requirements may include working on your feet for long periods of time, bending, stretching, climbing under or over obstacles to help an animal in need.
- Must be able to safely handle frightened or aggressive animals.
- Must be able to work evenings and weekends as required.
- Criminal record check and vulnerable sector screening.
- Valid driver's license and satisfactory driver's abstract.
- Adherence to Rainy River First Nations' drug test policy.
